Matthew 22:15-46

1. Read Matthew 22:15-22. What was the Pharisees plan? Why did they send their own disciples along with Herodians to question Jesus?
2. Christians are called to be like Jesus. Could the things said of him in verse 16 be said of you?
3. Why did Jesus call them hypocrites? How did he answer their question about taxes? What was their response?
4. Should Christians pay taxes to the government? Why? (Rom. 13:1)
5. Read Matthew 22:23-33. What did the Sadducees believe about the resurrection? Were they asking Jesus a sincere question? Did they expect an answer?
6. Why did Jesus accuse them of not knowing the Scriptures or the power of God? (See also Isaiah 26:19, Daniel 12:2, Job 19:25-27) What point was he making in v. 32?
7. What did Jesus teach about life after resurrection? Do people become angels?
8. Read Matthew 22:34-40. What is the greatest commandment? Why? What is the second? How do *all the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments*?
9. Read Matthew 22:41-46. Whose son is the Christ (Messiah)? How can he be both David's son and David's Lord?
10. What was the end result of all their questions?
