Daniel 11:36-12:13

1. Read 11:36-45. How are this King and his reign described in vv. 36-39? Though he shares much in common with Antiochus IV, how does this passage seem to go beyond Antiochus?
2. What are his religious beliefs? What does he worship?
3. Verse 40 begins with the phrase “at the time of the end.” At the end of what? What will characterize this time? (vv. 40-45)
4. Read 12:1-4. Chapter divisions were not part of the original text. Our chapter 12 flowed from chapter 11; they were connected to each other, not separate. Now we move from the earthly battle to the heavenly realities. These verses are the theological climax of the book. When will Michael come? Why? What will happen to God’s people? (v. 1)
5. What is taught here about the afterlife and the vindication that will come?
6. Read 12:5-13. Daniel’s vision concludes where it began – at the bank of the river in the presence of angelic beings. What question was asked by the angel? (v. 6) What was the answer? (v. 7) What do you think was meant by last part of v. 7?
7. What question did Daniel ask? How was it answered? What hope was he given? (vv. 8-11)
8. The time frame given in vv. 11-13 is confusing. Do you think God intended for us to figure it out? Why or why not? (Acts 1:7-8) What can be learned even without understanding the exact dates?
9. What was Daniel told to do? What assurance was he given? (v. 13) How does that apply to you and me?
10. What application for your own life will you take from studying the book of Daniel?
