Ruth - Lesson 2
Ruth 2:1-23

1. Read Ruth 2:1-3. Who was Boaz? What do we know about him?
2. Read Leviticus 19:9-10. What provision had God made for the poor and the aliens among the Israelites? What was Ruth willing to do to support herself and Naomi?
3. Use a dictionary or your computer to look up providence. How would you define the “providence of God”? Where do we first see God’s providential care of Ruth and Naomi? (v. 3) How have you experienced God’s providential care?
4. Read the rest of the chapter, Ruth 2:4-23. Though God is not directly mentioned, list the other incidences of His providential care throughout this chapter.
5. What can be learned about Ruth’s character?
6. What can be learned about Boaz’s character?
7. In verse 20, Naomi tells Ruth that Boaz is one of our “kinsman-redeemers”. What does that mean, and what could he do? (See also Lev. 25:23-28, 47-49, Deut. 25:5-10)
8. How is Boaz, as kinsman-redeemer, a picture of the greater reality of Christ our Redeemer?
