Daniel 6:1-28

1. Read 6:1-9. Why do you think the other men Darius appointed as leaders resented Daniel so much that they would go to such lengths to get rid of him? Why was Daniel's integrity the root of their problem?
2. What did they decide to do? Why? Were they honest with the King when presenting their proposal? Why do you think the King went along with it?
3. Read 6:10-14. How did Daniel, his opponents and the King respond to the decree? Why?
4. Read 6:15-20. How had Daniel's life of faith impacted the King?
5. Are we living in such a way that our critics, as well as those closest to us, know we are women of faith and that obedience to God comes first in our lives? Why or why not? What changes might we/you need to make?
6. What differing views of Daniel's God and His ability to save Daniel were held by the administrators and satraps, the King, and Daniel himself?
7. Read 6:21-24. How did God answer Daniel's prayer of v. 11? How is the end of the story a fulfillment of Proverbs 10:9 and 11:8?
8. Read 6:25-28. What truths about God were proclaimed by King Darius?
9. Why do you think God allowed Daniel to go into the lion's den when He could have prevented it? What do you find in this chapter that will help you in your own life when facing a difficult situation?
