Daniel 8:1-27

1. Read 8:1-14 (The Vision). In light of chapter 7, in general terms, what do the animals represent in Daniel's visions? The horns?
2. What did Daniel observe about the ram? What happened to it?
3. How does he describe the arrival of the goat? What is the most noteworthy feature of the goat? What does he accomplish? (vv. 5-7)
4. What change occurred to the goat in v. 8? And then in v. 9?
5. What was so different about the last horn? Where did he turn his attack? Was he successful?
6. What question was asked by the first angel? What was the answer? (vv. 13-14)
7. Read 8:15-27. (The Interpretation) Who interpreted the vision for Daniel? Why? What was Daniel's immediate response? What was he told the vision concerned? (v. 17, 19)
8. Who was represented by the ram? By the goat? By the large horn between its eyes? Who was he?
9. What happened after he died? The king described in vv. 9-12 and 23-26 was Antiochus IV who turned against the Jews and desecrated the temple in the 2nd century. How is he described? What will happen to him?
10. What do these visions of the past have to do with us today? How is Antiochus an apt symbol of the Antichrist? What is the ultimate battle that is taking place? How will it end? When?
