Daniel – Lesson 10  
Daniel 9:1-19

1. Read Daniel 9:1-3, Jeremiah 25:7-12 & 29:1,10-14. Why does Daniel turn to God in prayer at this time? How did he view the words of Jeremiah the prophet?
2. How seriously did Daniel take prayer? What preparations had he made?
3. Read Daniel 9:4-6. What does Daniel acknowledge about God in verse 4?
4. Read Deut. 28:1-2, 15, 36-37; 30:1-10. Daniel addresses God as LORD (covenant name Yahweh) in Daniel 9: 2, 4, 8, 10, 13 & 14. How is the covenant the basis for his prayer?
5. Read Daniel 9:7-11a. According to Daniel, why are they *covered with shame*? (Compare their current situation in exile to the promises of Deut. 7:6, 28:7, 28:9-11)
6. Read Daniel 9:11b-14. Why had such a disaster fallen on God's chosen people? Who had they sinned against? Did Daniel offer any excuse or defense for the guilt of his people? What did he acknowledge about the character of God?
7. Read Daniel 9:15-19. What had God done for them in the past? Why did Daniel mention that? What did he ask God to do? (v. 16) What is the basis for his appeal? (v. 18b)
8. Notice the number of times Daniel uses the word "your" (meaning "God's") in vv. 15-19. What was Daniel's underlying concern for God?
9. What insights about your own prayer life can you learn from Daniel's prayer?
